

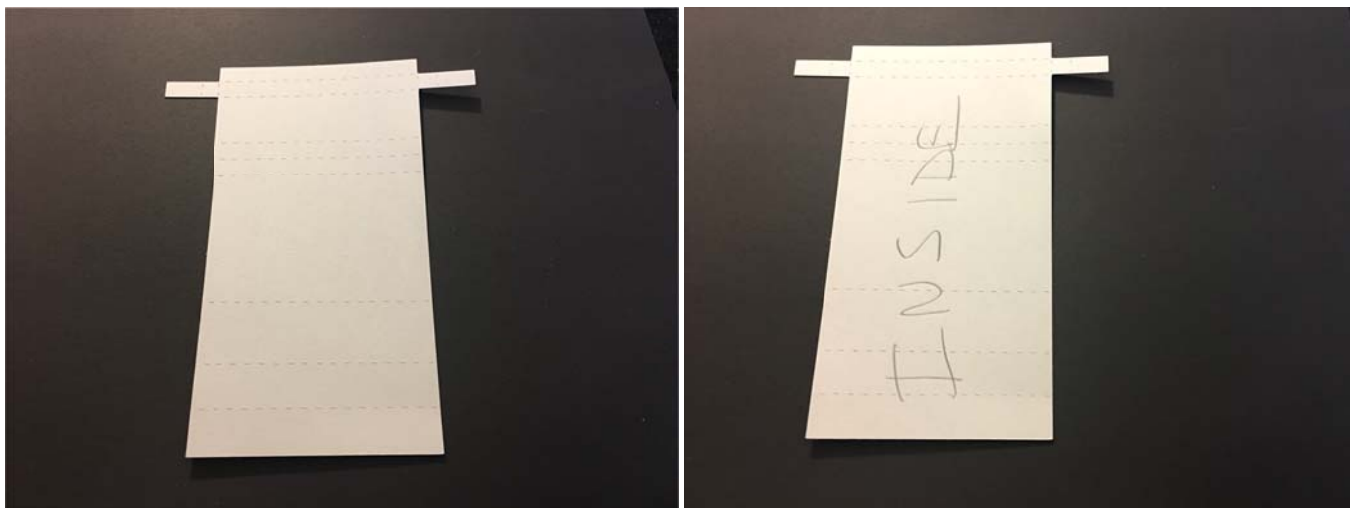
Warfighter Enemy Sleds

Assembly Instructions

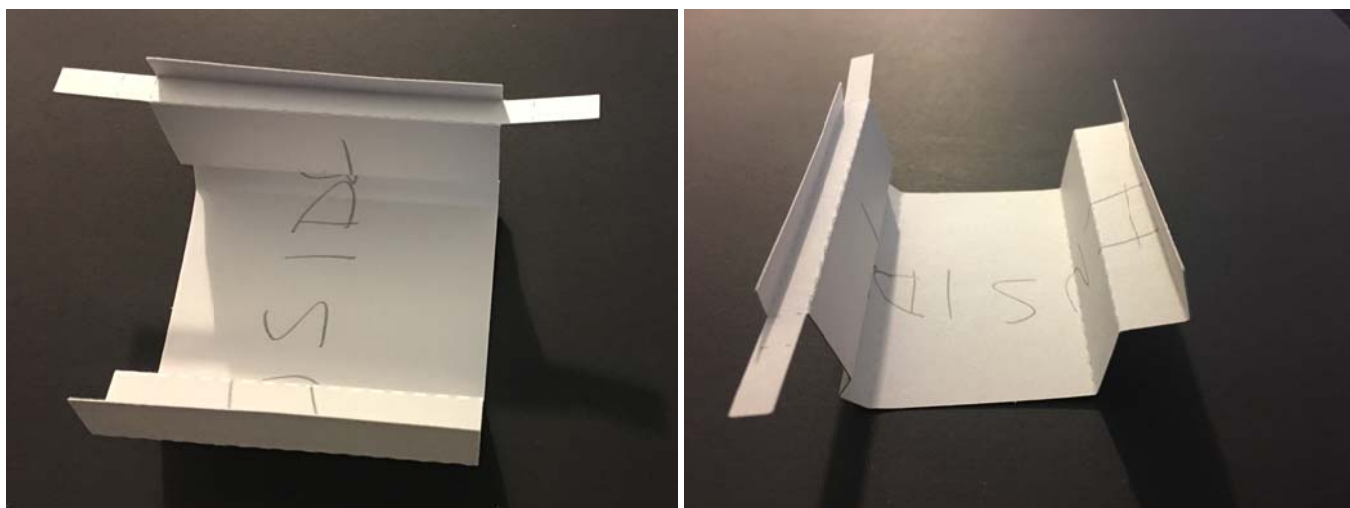
1. Download the enemy sleds file from the files section of Warfighter WW2 on boardgamegeek.com.
2. Print the file at 100% on Cardstock (110# is best, but 60# should work as well)
3. Cut each of the three sleds on the solid lines and score on the dashed lines for folding.

You're now ready to begin assembly!



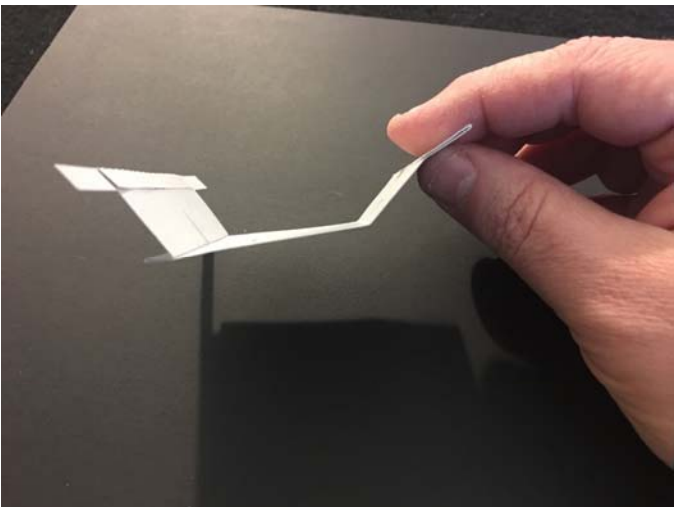
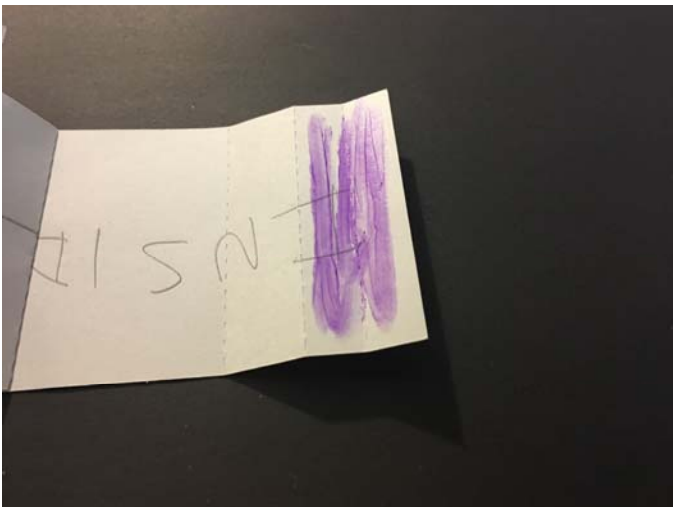
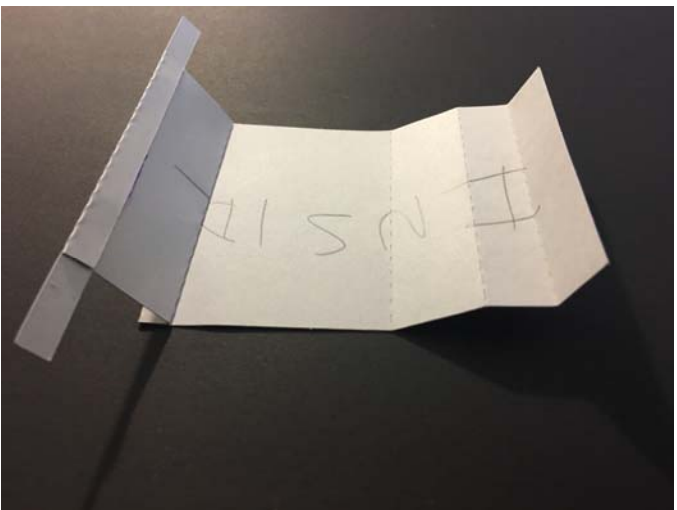
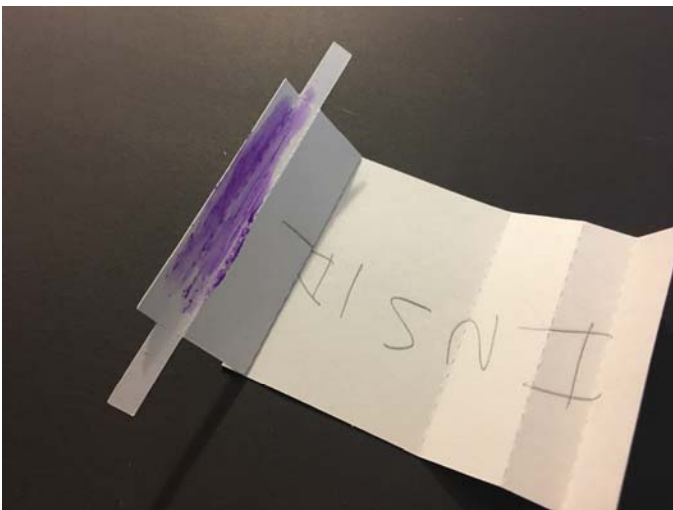
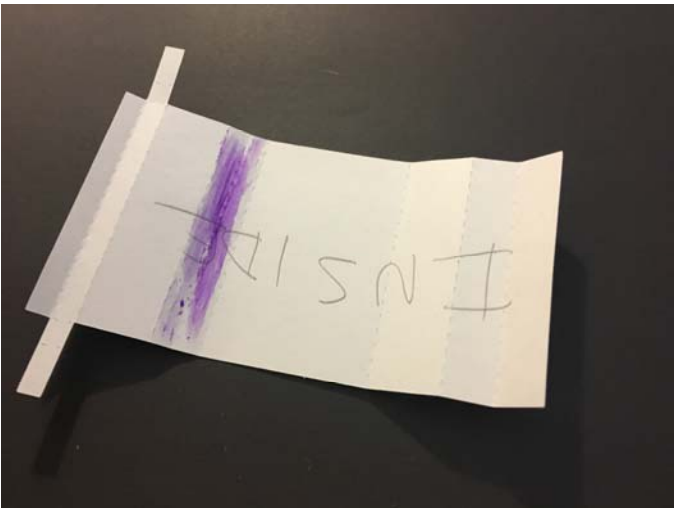
A cut and scored template. "INSIDE" added for demonstration purposes.

The diagram on the template sheet shows the flow of the template in terms of folds.

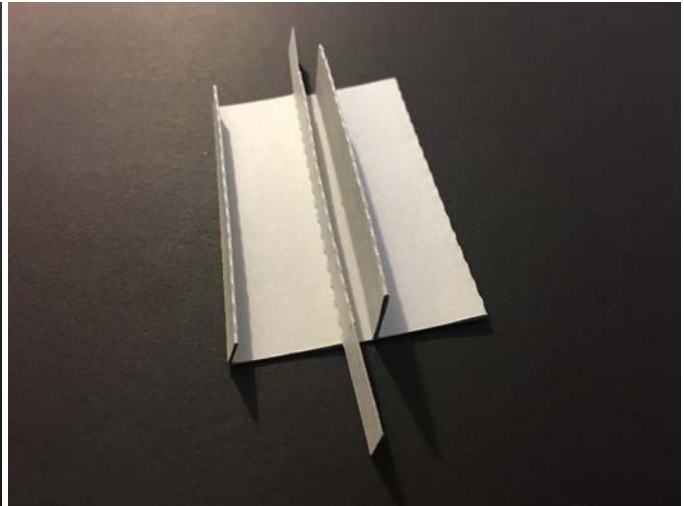
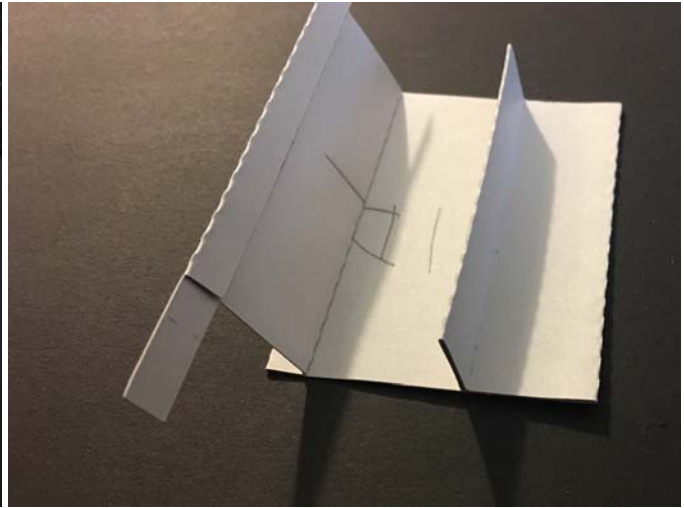
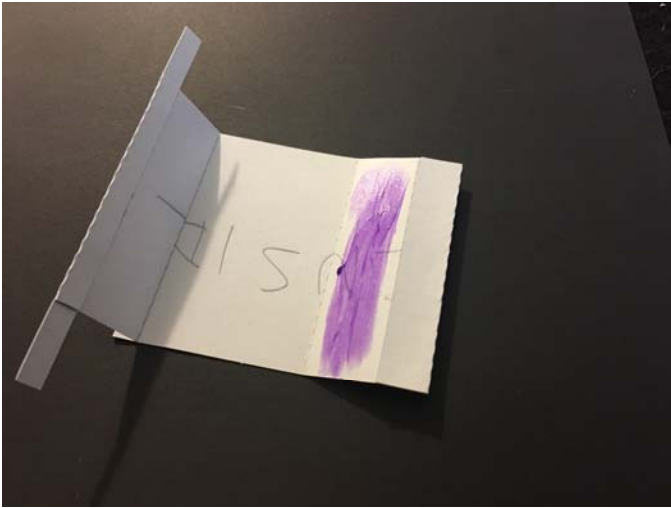


Fold along the score lines so your template looks as above.

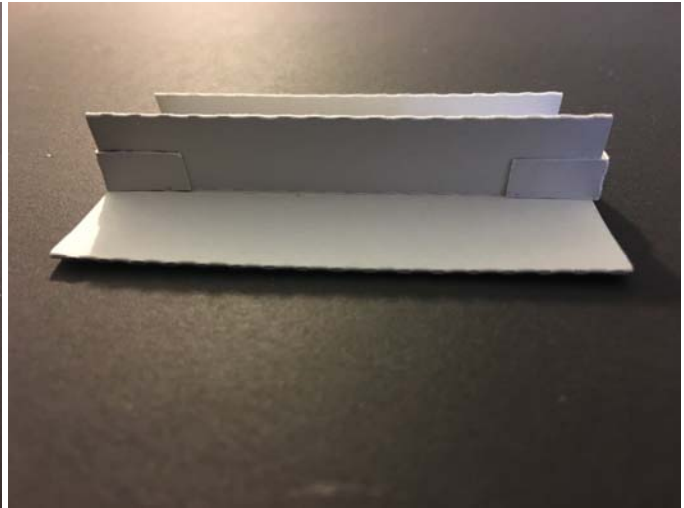
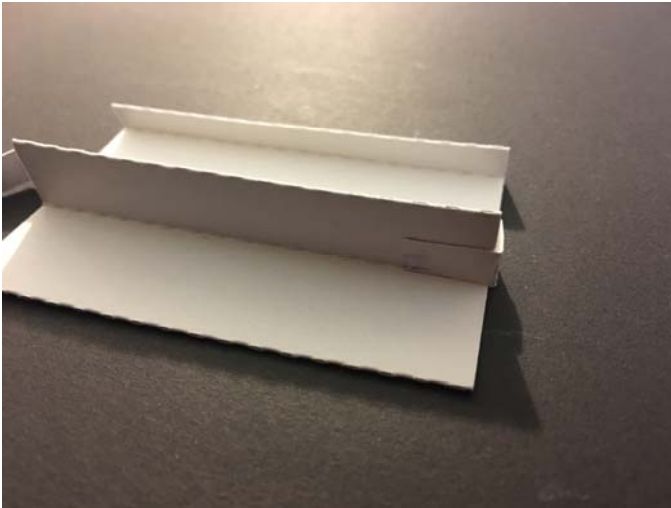
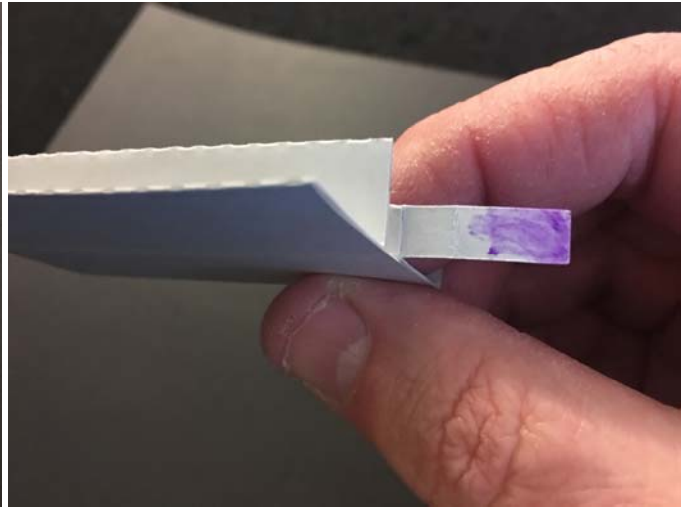
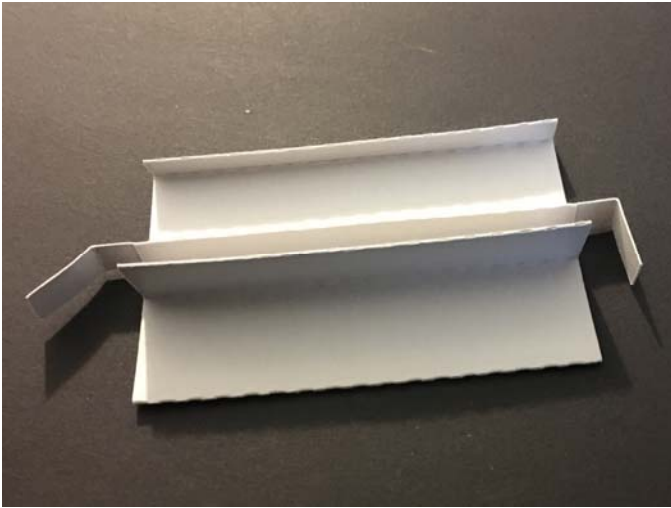
Using glue (glue stick preferred), glue together each of the three peaks of the sled.



Next, glue the body of each section (the counter tray and the back balance area) and secure to the base of the sled. This will result in the peaks being up. As you can see the "INSIDE" text is the inside of the sled as it folds over itself.



Now fold the longer part of each side tab toward the taller wall of the card slot and then apply glue ONLY to the longer part which will wrap around and attach to the back of the tall wall. The smaller section of each tab will serve as the side walls of the card slot. Repeat for both sides.



Your Warfighter enemy sled is now complete and ready for play.
